Gawthorpe Hall is a Jacobean house built in 1605 for the Shuttleworth family, and has remained virtually untouched ever since. It is home to the internationally renowned Rachel Kay-Shuttleworth Textile Collection with over 200 items on display from all over the world.

Entrance to the Hall is £4.00, Concessions £3.00. Free to National Trust and Art Fund members, please show your membership cards on arrival.

Prior to the visit to Gawthorpe we will stop at Oswaldtwistle Mills, giving our members time to explore the store and Garden Centre and have lunch (lunch can be purchased from a range of outlets) , before leaving for Gawthorpe at 13.00. On arrival at Gawthorpe the party will split in two with one group visiting the Textile Exhibition first, the other group touring the Hall, changing over after an hour.

The coach will be returning from Gawthorpe at 16.00 to arrive at Leyland approx. 17.30
