### BEGINNERS' QUILTING AND PATCHWORK

Come along and make a shopping tote bag using a method to join strips of fabric, learn how to quilt this and complete a lovely bag to take home. Pam will also show you how to add an edging to a patchwork project and mitre the corners.

**This course is for beginners;** a list of materials is below. The tutor will supply a piece of wadding and mitre kit at a cost of £5.00 (payable on the day to the Tutor).

**A sewing machine, please check this before coming on the course and insert a new needle. Sewing kit, sewing thread to match plus a darker thread for the quilting, cutting mat, rotary cutter, Scissors, hand sewing needle/pins, cutting ruler, walking foot if you have one, the weight of wadding I will provide will take the usual foot. Accurately cut, 20, 12 1/2 by 2 1/2 rectangles of different coloured, same weight cotton fabrics. You could use 2 or 3 fabrics to make up the stripy pattern if 20 different ones is difficult. 1/2 m cotton fabric for the base. Use a colour to match your prints. 1m for lining and straps, plain or patterned. Curtain lining is OK for this whilst this is a beginner project. Look what you have in your stash. Don't bring dress linings or nylon fabric. If you want different coloured handles to the lining accurately cut 2 pieces 6" by 36" from a contrast fabric. This may match one of your pieces! 1 piece of contrast colour to the lining, 10" x 13" for a pocket (optional)**
